These Terms of Use (“**Terms**”) govern the use of the Website and any associated online products, platforms, applications, software, or services, (collectively, “**Services**”), by you or any entity you represent (“**You**” and “**Your**”). In some instances, both these Terms and separate terms issued and/or offered by Compassion setting forth additional conditions may apply to specific Services offered (“**Additional Terms**”). To the extent there is a conflict between these Terms and any Additional Terms, the Additional Terms will control unless the Additional Terms expressly state otherwise.

By visiting the Website or otherwise using the Services in any manner, You acknowledge, accept, and agree to be bound by these Terms, including the binding arbitration terms in Section 9, and any applicable Additional Terms. You also acknowledge, agree, and consent to our data practices with respect to personal information that may be obtained through the Website or Services as more fully described in our Privacy Policy <https://www.compassion.com/privacy-policy.htm>.

By visiting the Website or otherwise using the Services, You represent and warrant that You, your financial institutions, or any entity You own or control, or, if You are authorized to act on behalf of an entity, the entity that owns or controls You, are not subject to sanctions or otherwise designated on any list of prohibited or restricted parties, including but not limited to lists maintained by the United Nations Security Council, the U.S. Government (including without limitation, the Specially Designated Nationals List and Foreign Sanctions Evaders List of the U.S. Department of Treasury and the Entity List of the U.S. Department of Commerce), the European Union or its Member States, or other applicable government authority, and not located in any country to which the United States has embargoed goods or has otherwise applied any sanctions.

Compassion may choose to offer additional services or cease to offer any Service currently provided, at any time, at its sole discretion.

FULL ONLINE TERMS OF USE

1. OWNERSHIP AND YOUR RIGHTS TO USE THE SERVICE AND CONTENT.

1.1. Ownership. The Website and Services contain materials and other items relating to Compassion, including layout, information, databases, articles, posts, text, data, files, images, scripts, designs, graphics, instructions, illustrations, photographs, sounds, pictures, videos, advertising copy, URLs, technology, software, interactive features, and the “look and feel” of the Service, (together, the “**Content**”) including all copyrights, patents, trademarks, service marks, trade names, and all other intellectual property rights therein (“**Intellectual Property**”). All Content herein is owned or controlled by Compassion, its licensors, or certain other parties. All rights, title, and interest in and to the Content available via the Services are the property of Compassion, its licensors, or certain other parties, and are protected by U.S. and international copyright, trademark, trade dress, patent and/or other intellectual property and unfair competition rights and laws to the fullest extent possible. Compassion owns the copyright in the selection, compilation, assembly, arrangement, and enhancement of the Content on the Services.

1.2. Your Rights to Use the Services and Content. Subject to Your strict compliance with these Terms and any applicable Additional Terms, Compassion grants you a limited, non-exclusive, revocable, non-commercial, non-assignable, personal, and non-transferable license to download, display, view, or use the Website, Services, or Content on a computer, mobile, or other Internet-enabled or permitted device (“**Device**”) as it is displayed to you for your personal, non-commercial use only (“**Licensed Elements**”). The foregoing limited license does not give you any ownership of, or any other intellectual property interest in, any Content. Your unauthorized use of the Services or Content may violate copyright, trademark, privacy, publicity, communications, and other laws, and any such use may result in your personal liability, including potential criminal liability. Your right to access and use the Services and the Intellectual Property shall automatically terminate upon any violations. As Your right to access and use the Services and the Content is personal to You, You may not assign or transfer your right; any attempt to do so is void.

1.3. Communication. - 1.6. Account Registration.** If applicable, You may register for a personal account (and/or related username and password) on the Website (“**Account**”) and use such Account to interact with the Website, Services, and Content as more fully explained in Section 5 below.
- 1.7. Compassion reserves the right to suspend or prohibit linking to the Website or Services for any reason, in its sole discretion, without advance notice or any liability of any kind.
- 1.8. Other.** You may use any other functionality expressly provided by Compassion on the Website or through the Services for use, subject to these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms.
- 1.9. Rights of Others.** Your use of the Website and any Services hereunder may not violate the rights of Compassion or any third-party, including without limitation, intellectual property rights, rights of publicity, and rights of privacy. Any unauthorized use of the Content contained herein, or the related intellectual property rights thereof, that violates the rights of others or any applicable laws may result in Your civil and criminal liability. Any third-party that believes his/her work has been infringed via the Services, *see* Section 6 below.
- 1.10. Reservation of Rights.** These Terms and any applicable Additional Terms include only narrow, limited grants of rights to use and access the Website, Services, and Content contained herein. ALL RIGHTS NOT EXPRESSLY GRANTED TO YOU ARE RESERVED BY COMPASSION AND ITS LICENSORS AND OTHER PARTIES. No right or license may be construed, under any legal theory, by implication, estoppel, industry custom, or otherwise. Any unauthorized use of the Website, Content, or Services for any purpose is strictly prohibited.
- 1.11. Other Online Services.** Compassion is not responsible for other online services or their content or advertisement(s) (“**Other Online Services**”). For instance, portions of the Services may be

integrated into or linked to other platforms that Compassion does not control. This may include the ability to share the Content on third-party sites and services using plug-ins made available via this Website. Please note that Other Online Services have their own privacy policies and terms of use and Compassion is not responsible or liable for these policies or terms.

2. NONFUNGIBLE TOKEN CREATION, RIGHTS, AND TRANSFERS.

2.1. NFT Creation. The Services provided by Compassion hereunder include a proprietary self-serve software application that will allow You to create, custody, and transfer a nonfungible token (“NFT”) on the Ethereum Network. Compassion **does not** create, custody, or transfer NFTs for You, to You, or on Your behalf.

2.2. Representations and Warranties. You represent and warrant that (i) You, and not Compassion, are the creator, minter, initial holder, and initial owner of any and all NFTs generated using the Services; and (ii) You are solely responsible under any applicable law or regulation related to any such act of creating, minting, holding custody of, transferring, or otherwise taking any action related to any NFTs created by You using these Services.

2.3. NFT Media. Any media that is attached to any NFT that You create via the Services (“NFT Media”) is the subject of a copyright exclusively owned by Compassion, as set forth below in Section 2.5.2.1 below.

2.4. Use of Third-Party Applications. In order to use the Services, Compassion may require You to independently obtain access to certain third-party applications, and provide Compassion with certain information related to such third-party applications.

2.5. NFT Rights.

2.5.1. Your Rights.

2.5.1.1. Intellectual Property. You shall not have any intellectual property rights in and to the NFT Media except for the limited licenses as set forth below.

2.5.1.2. NFT Custody and Transfer. Any and all NFTs created or minted by You via these Services shall be initially owned and custodied by You. Thereafter, such NFTs shall be freely transferable to any third party at Your sole discretion on the Ethereum Network blockchain, and You shall have all rights necessary to effectuate such transfers. However, any such transfer shall be at Your own risk and expense and Compassion shall have no liability to You as more fully outlined in Section 2.7 below.

2.5.1.3. Limited License. You or any third-party transferee of the NFTs (“NFT Holders”) shall have the right to custody the NFT on the Ethereum Network and shall have the right to view and display the NFT Media – for non-commercial and personal purposes only and consistent with these Terms, any applicable Additional Terms and any applicable law. You or any NFT Holders do not have the right to (i) modify the NFT Media in any way, including, without limitation, the shapes, designs, drawings, attributes, or color schemes; (ii) use the NFT Media to advertise, market, or sell any third party product or service; (iii) use the NFT Media in connection with images, videos, or other forms of media that depict hatred, intolerance, violence, cruelty, or anything else that could reasonably be found to constitute hate speech or otherwise infringe upon the rights of others; (iv) use the NFT Media in movies, videos, or any other forms of media, except to the limited extent that

such use is expressly permitted in these Terms or solely for your own personal, non-commercial use; (v) sell, distribute for commercial gain (including, without limitation, giving away in the hopes of eventual commercial gain), or otherwise commercialize merchandise that includes, contains, or consists of the NFT Media, except as expressly permitted in these Terms; (vi) attempt to trademark, copyright, or otherwise acquire additional intellectual property rights in or to the NFT Media; (vii) create derivative works based on the NFT Media, or (viii) otherwise utilize the NFT Media for Your or any third party's commercial benefit.]

2.5.1.4. Other General Rights. At the sole discretion of Compassion, and subject to any additional terms and conditions as may be imposed by Compassion in its sole discretion, NFT Holders may, in some instances, be granted the right to receive physical/consumptive items of nominal value and may be granted certain access rights.

2.5.1.5. No Other Rights Granted. Except for the rights specifically set forth in this Section 2.5.1, under these Terms You shall be entitled to no other rights or benefits with respect to any NFTs or NFT Media.

2.5.2. Compassion's NFT Rights.

2.5.2.1. Copyright. Compassion shall be the sole and exclusive owner of the copyright in and to the NFT Media with all rights under applicable law including without limitation the right to (i) use the NFT Media for marketing purposes; (ii) monetize the NFT Media in any medium now known or hereinafter devised; and (ii) transfer, assign, or license its copyright interest in the NFT Media to any third party at its sole discretion.]

2.5.2.2. Other Intellectual Property. Compassion shall be the sole owner of any derivative content ("**Derivative Content**") generated during Your creation or minting of NFTs using the Services. Such Derivative Content includes, but is not limited to, all text, software, scripts, code, designs, graphics, photos, sounds, music, videos, applications, interactive features, articles, news stories, sketches, animations, textures, lighting, camera work, background, color schemes, algorithms, materials, patterns, animations, physical items, general artwork and/or other related content.

2.5.2.3. Royalties. Any NFT You create using the Website or Services may now or in the future be designed with a "perpetual royalty" feature, using Ethereum Network functionality, whereby any time the NFT is transferred by You to a third party, or from a third party to another third party, a defined percentage of the purchase price paid by the transferee may be automatically sent to Compassion in the form of Ether cryptocurrency ("**Royalty Payment**"). Any such Royalty Payment made is based on Compassion's ownership interest in and to the copyright in the NFT Media.

2.5.2.4. NFT Burning or Disassociation. Compassion reserves the right to (i) "burn" (i.e., to obtain and to destroy or otherwise neutralize) any NFT or (ii) disassociate the NFT Media from any NFT created or minted using the Services that violates these Terms, violates any applicable law or regulation, or that Compassion, in its sole discretion, determines to be harmful in any way to Compassion, You, or any third party.

2.5.2.5. Reservation of Rights. Compassion hereby reserves all rights not expressly set forth in these Terms with respect to any NFT Media or NFTs created or minted through Your use of the Services.

2.6. Price and Payment Terms. In exchange for the limited revocable right to use the Services, You shall pay to Compassion all fees as indicated by the Services. As permitted by applicable law, Compassion shall have the right to refuse or cancel any applicable orders in its sole discretion. Your potential orders are offers to purchase subject to Compassion’s acceptance, which it may, but is not required to, reject or cancel subject to refund. Additional Terms may apply.

2.7. NFT Transfers. If after you mint a NFT through the Services You elect to transfer it to a third party (“**NFT Transfer**”), this NFT Transfer may be conducted solely through the Ethereum Network blockchain, with or without the use of a third-party platform. Compassion has no control over any such transfers or related financial transactions, nor does Compassion have the ability to reverse any payments or transactions conducted on the Ethereum Network blockchain. Compassion has no liability to You or any third party for any claims or damages that may arise as a result of any NFT Transfer in which You engage. In addition, any NFT Transfer in which You engage will require the payment of “gas fees.” Gas fees fund the network of computers that run the decentralized Ethereum Network blockchain. This means that You will need to pay, and will be solely responsible for, any gas fees associated with any NFT Transfers that you initiate.

2.8. Taxes. You will be solely responsible for paying any and all sales, use, value-added, and other taxes, duties and assessments (except taxes on Compassion’s net income) now or hereafter claimed or imposed by any governmental authority associated with Your use of the Services.

3. CONTENT YOU SUBMIT AND USAGE RULES.

3.1. General. Compassion may now, or in the future, provide the opportunity to create, build, post, upload, display, publish, distribute, transmit, broadcast, or otherwise make available on or submit to Compassion (i) through the Website, (ii) its Services, or (iii) via certain third-party platforms, in connection with any Compassion marketing or promotions in any media or manner, messages, text, illustrations, files, images, graphics, photos, comments, responses, sounds, music, videos, information, content, ratings, reviews, data, questions, suggestions, personally identifiable information, or other information or materials and the ideas contained therein, (collectively, “**User-Generated Content**” or “**UGC**”). Subject to the rights and licenses You grant Compassion under these Terms and subject to any applicable Additional Terms, You retain whatever legally identifiable right, title, and interest that you may have in your UGC, provided, however, that none of Your UGC contains any Content or NFT Media.

3.2. Non-Confidentiality of UGC. Except as otherwise described in our posted Privacy Policy <https://www.compassion.com/privacy-policy.htm>, or any applicable Additional Terms, You agree that (i) any UGC will be treated as non-confidential and non-proprietary by Compassion – regardless of whether you mark them “confidential,” “proprietary,” or the like, (ii) any UGC submitted will not be returned, and (iii) to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Compassion does not assume any obligation of any kind to You or any third-party with respect to the UGC. Upon request, You will provide documentation necessary to authenticate rights to such content and verify Your compliance with these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms. You acknowledge that the Internet and mobile communications may not be secure and may be subject to breaches of security. Accordingly, You acknowledge and agree that UGC is submitted to Compassion at your own risk.

3.3. License to Compassion of UGC. Except as otherwise described in any applicable Additional Terms that specifically govern the submission of your UGC, You hereby grant Compassion, the non-exclusive, unrestricted, unconditional, unlimited, worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual, and cost-

free right and license to use, copy, record, distribute, reproduce, disclose, sell, re-sell, sublicense (through multiple levels), display, publicly perform, transmit, publish, broadcast, translate, make derivative works of, and otherwise use and exploit in any manner whatsoever, all or any portion of your UGC (and derivative works thereof), for any purpose whatsoever in all formats, on or through any means or medium now known or hereafter developed, and with any technology or devices now known or hereafter developed, and to advertise, market, and promote the same. Without limitation, the rights granted include the right to: (i) configure, host, index, cache, archive, store, digitize, compress, optimize, modify, reformat, edit, adapt, publish in searchable format, and remove such UGC and combine the same with other materials, and (ii) use any ideas, concepts, know-how, or techniques contained in any UGC for any purposes whatsoever, including developing, producing, and marketing products and/or services. In exercising its rights hereunder, Compassion may remove or alter metadata, notices, and content, including copyright management information from the UGC. You consent to such alteration and/or removal and further represent and warrant that You have all necessary authority to do so. As permitted by applicable law, You grant Compassion the unconditional, perpetual, and irrevocable right to use and exploit Your name, persona, and likeness in connection with any UGC, without any obligation or remuneration to You. Except as prohibited by law, You waive any moral rights (including attribution and integrity) that you may have in any UGC, even if it is altered or changed in a manner not agreeable to You. To the extent not waivable, You irrevocably agree not to exercise such moral rights (if any) in a manner that interferes with Compassion's exercise of the granted rights. You understand that you will not receive any fees, sums, consideration, or remuneration for any of the rights granted in this Section 3.3.

3.4. Representations and Warranties Related to UGC. Each time you submit any UGC for use in the Services, You represent and warrant that (i) You are at least the age of majority in the jurisdiction in which You reside, (ii) You are the parent or legal guardian, or have all proper consents from the parent or legal guardian, of any minor who is depicted in or contributed to any UGC you submit, and (iii) as to all UGC, (a) You are the sole author and owner of all intellectual property and other rights in and to the UGC, (b) You have a lawful right or authority to submit the UGC and grant Compassion the rights under these Terms and any applicable Additional Terms, without the need for Compassion to obtain consent of any third-party and without creating any other obligation or liability of Compassion; (c) the UGC is accurate; (d) the UGC does not and, as to Compassion's permitted uses and exploitation set forth in these Terms, will not infringe any right of any third-party, including without limitation intellectual property rights, rights of publicity, and rights of privacy; and (e) the UGC will not violate these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms, or cause injury or harm to any person.

3.5. Enforcement. Compassion has no obligation to monitor or enforce any intellectual property rights to Your UGC, but You grant Compassion the right to protect and enforce its rights in and to Your UGC, including initiating actions in Your name and on Your behalf (at Compassion's cost and expense, to which you hereby consent and irrevocably appoint Compassion as your attorney-in-fact, with the power of substitution and delegation, which appointment is coupled with an interest).

3.6. Your UGC. All UGC must either originate from You or You must obtain all necessary rights in and to it from third parties in order to permit Your compliance with these Terms and any applicable Additional Terms. Your UGC should not contain any visible logos, phrases, or trademarks that belong to third parties. Do not use any UGC that belongs to other people and pass it off as Your own; this includes any content that You might have found elsewhere on the Internet. If anyone contributes to your UGC or has any rights to Your UGC, or if anyone appears or is referenced in the UGC, then You must also have their permission to submit such UGC to Compassion. (For example, if someone has taken a picture of you and your friend, and you submit that photo to

Compassion as your UGC, then you must obtain the permission of your friend and the photographer to do so).

3.7. Offensive Content. If You think your UGC might offend someone or be embarrassing to someone, then chances are it probably will, and it doesn't belong on the Services. Cursing, harassing, stalking, insulting comments, personal attacks, gossip, and similar actions are prohibited. Your UGC must not threaten, abuse, or harm others, and it must not include any negative comments that are connected to race, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or handicap. Your UGC must not be defamatory, slanderous, indecent, obscene, pornographic, or sexually explicit. Your UGC must not exploit children under the age of 18. Without limitation, Compassion may, but does not commit to, address content as outlined in this Section 3.7 that comes to our attention that we believe, at our sole discretion, is offensive, obscene, lewd, lascivious, filthy, violent, harassing, threatening, abusive, illegal or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate, detracts from the public image or reflects unfavorably upon Compassion or its products or services, inconsistent with the stated core values of Compassion, denigrates or exploits the poor or impoverished in our society or any society, or to enforce the rights of third parties or these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms.

3.8. Do Not Use for Inappropriate Purposes. Your UGC must not promote any infringing, illegal, or other similarly inappropriate activity.

3.9. Be Honest and Do Not Misrepresent Yourself or Your UGC. Do not impersonate any other individual, user, or company, and do not submit UGC that you believe may be false, fraudulent, deceptive, inaccurate, or misleading, or that misrepresents your identity or affiliation with a person or company. In the event you receive anything in consideration from Compassion with respect to your UGC (e.g., coupons, sweepstakes entries, etc.) You represent you will include disclosure of the receipt of this consideration clearly and conspicuously as part of the UGC and include any other disclosures we may require.

3.10. UGC Violations. If You submit UGC that Compassion reasonably believes violates these Terms, Compassion may take any legally available action that it deems appropriate, in its sole discretion. We may require, at any time, proof of the permissions referred to above in a form acceptable to us. Failure to provide such proof may lead to, among other things, removal from use of the Services.

4. SERVICES AND CONTENT USE RESTRICTIONS.

4.1. Services Use Restrictions. You agree that You will not: (i) use the Services for any political or commercial purpose in competition with us (including, without limitation, for purposes of advertising, soliciting funds, collecting product prices, and selling products); (ii) use any meta tags or any other "hidden text" utilizing any Intellectual Property; (iii) use the Services to engage in any activities that harm or attempt to harm any individuals or entities; (iv) use the Services in a manner that is unlawful, offensive, obscene, lewd, lascivious, filthy, violent, threatening, harassing, or abusive, that violates any right of any third-party, or that is otherwise objectionable to Compassion; (v) use the Services to decompile, disassemble, reverse engineer, or attempt to reconstruct, identify, or discover any source code, underlying ideas, underlying user interface techniques, or algorithms of the Services by any means whatsoever; (vi) modify any source or object code accessible on the Service nor other products, services, or processes accessible through any portion of the Services; (vii) engage in any activity that interferes with another user's access to the Services, the proper operation of the Services, or that otherwise causes harm to the Services, Compassion, or other users of the Services; (viii) interfere with or circumvent any security feature (including any digital rights

management mechanism, device, or other content protection or access control measure) of the Services or any feature that restricts or limits the use of or access to the Services, the Content, or the UGC; (viii) harvest or otherwise collect or store any information, including personally identifiable information about other users of the Services, including email addresses, without the express consent of such users; (ix) attempt to gain unauthorized access to the Services or other computer systems or networks connected to the Services through password mining or any other means; or (x) otherwise violate these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms.

4.2. Content Use Restrictions. 9. **DISPUTE RESOLUTION; MANDATORY BINDING ARBITRATION; CLASS ACTION, CLASS ARBITRATION, AND COLLECTIVE ARBITRATION WAIVERS.**

9.1. YOU AND COMPASSION AGREE TO ARBITRATE – RATHER THAN LITIGATE – any and all claims, disputes, or controversies between you and Compassion, including any parents, subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, or agents of Compassion, whether based in contract, statute, regulation, ordinance, tort (including, but not limited to, fraud, misrepresentation, fraudulent inducement, negligence, or any other intentional tort) or other legal or equitable theory (collectively “**Disputes**”) that arise out of or in any way relate to these Terms, any of the Services provided hereunder or any other services or products that Compassion may offer or provide to You in connection with these Terms (including without limitation amounts that Compassion charges You for services or products provided, any alleged breach related to the collection, retention or disclosure of your personal information, and any alleged violation of our Privacy Policy <https://www.compassion.com/privacy-policy.htm>. The term “Dispute” means any and all past, present or future disputes, claims or controversies between You and Compassion, whether based in contract, statute, regulation, ordinance, tort (including, without limitation, fraud, misrepresentation, fraudulent inducement, negligence or any other intentional tort) or any other legal or equitable theory, and includes, without limitation, any such disputes, claims or controversies arising out of or relating to the validity, enforceability, interpretation and/or scope of this dispute resolution agreement, provided, however, that the term “Dispute” does not include any such disputes, claims or controversies arising out of or relating to the validity, enforceability, interpretation and/or scope of the Class Action, Class Action Arbitration and Collective Arbitration Waivers set forth in Section 9.2 below, or whether claims to resolve any Disputes must proceed solely on an individual basis, all of which shall be decided by a court of competent jurisdiction, and not by an arbitrator. With that sole exception which shall be broadly construed, the term “Dispute” shall be given the broadest possible meaning. You and Compassion also agree to arbitrate any and all Disputes that arise out of or relate in any way to any services or products provided to You by Compassion under any other agreement. No arbitrator shall have the authority to consolidate, join, or allow the coordination of more than one (1) person’s claims or to preside over a class, collective, mass, or representative proceeding in any form. No arbitrator shall have the authority to determine the enforceability of this Section 9.2. If you or Compassion brings a claim in small claims court, the

Class Action Waiver will apply, and neither of us can bring a claim on a class or representative basis. Furthermore, neither you nor Compassion may participate in a class or representative action as a class member if the class action asserts Disputes that would fall within the scope of this arbitration agreement if they were directly asserted by you or Compassion. Both parties agree that this Class Action Waiver is an essential part of this arbitration agreement and that if this Class Action Waiver is found to be unenforceable by any court, then the entire arbitration agreement set forth in this Section 9 will not apply to any Disputes between you and Compassion except for the provisions of Section 9.6 waiving the right to a jury trial. This Class Action and Collective Arbitration Waiver may not be severed from our arbitration agreement.

If the claim asserted in arbitration is for less than \$75,000, the AAA's Consumer Arbitration Rules will apply. If the claim asserted is for \$75,000 or more, the Commercial Arbitration Rules will apply. If there is a conflict between the AAA's rules and this dispute resolution agreement, this dispute resolution agreement shall control. 14.5. Investigations; Cooperation with Law Enforcement; Termination; Survival. As permitted by applicable law, Compassion reserves the right, without limitation, to: (i) investigate any suspected breaches of the Services' security or its information technology or other systems or networks, (ii) investigate any suspected breaches of these Terms and any applicable Additional

Terms, (iii) use any information obtained by Compassion in accordance with its Privacy Policy <https://www.compassion.com/privacy-policy.htm> in connection with reviewing law enforcement databases or complying with Applicable Laws and use and/or disclose any information obtained by Compassion to comply with law enforcement requests or legal requirements in accordance with its Privacy Policy <https://www.compassion.com/privacy-policy.htm> (iv) involve and cooperate with law enforcement authorities in investigating any of the foregoing matters, (v) prosecute violators of these Terms and any applicable Additional Terms, and (vi) discontinue the Services, in whole or in part, or, suspend or terminate your access to it, in whole or in part, including any user accounts or registrations, at any time, without notice, for any reason and without any obligation to You or any third-party. Any suspension or termination will not affect Your obligations to Compassion under these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms. Upon suspension or termination of Your access to the Services, or upon notice from Compassion, all rights granted to You under these Terms, or any applicable Additional Terms, will cease immediately, and You agree that you will immediately discontinue use of the Services. These Terms and any applicable Additional Terms may not be assigned by You, and You may not delegate your duties under them, without the prior written consent of an officer of Compassion.

14.7. Entire Agreement; No Waiver. These Terms, and any applicable Additional Terms, reflect the entire agreement between You and Compassion regarding the use of the Website, Content, and Services and supersede any prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, warranties, assurances, or discussion related to the Services or regarding the subject matter herein. Except as expressly set forth in these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms, (i) any failure or delay in exercising any of the rights, powers, or remedies under these Terms or other legal right will not operate as a waiver of such or any other right, power, or remedy, and (ii) any waiver of any provision of these Terms or any applicable Additional Terms will not be effective unless made in writing and signed by the party against whom the waiver is sought to be enforced.

14.8. Applicable Law. These Terms and any applicable Additional Terms will be governed by and construed in accordance with, and any Dispute will be resolved in accordance with, the laws of the State of Colorado, without regard to its conflicts of law provisions that might apply the laws of another jurisdiction.

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
